

VETERAN PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIP

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

All games shall be played in accordance with:

- The laws of the sport of Bowls Crystal Mark 4TH Edition; and • Domestic regulations of Bowls South Africa; and the following Conditions of play:

- All team members shall be from the same club.
- All players shall be uniformly dressed in approved Club colours
- Play starts at 9.00 am for sectional play and for playoffs.
- The championship is to be played with three bowls in sections of four teams. In the event of 3 teams in a section: Round 1 – Team 1 vs Team 2. Round 2 – Loser vs Team 3. Round 3 – Winner round 1 vs Team 3.
- **All** sectional games shall be played on a league system over 18 ends to decide the winner of the section.
- The play-offs of section winners shall be played over 18 ends on a knockout basis.
- Points and shots will determine the sectional winner/s.
- **One trial** end is allowed at the start of each **sectional game**.
- **Two trial** ends are allowed at the start of each **playoff game**.
- Allocation of rinks. Round 1, open draw for rinks. Round 2, rinks will be assigned. Round 3, rinks will be assigned to if the play is in the same direction as rounds 1 & 2. If direction of play has changed, then an open draw for rinks will take place.
- No smoking within 2 metres of the green.
- No alcohol consumption is permitted during play incl. off the green.

POINTS ALLOCATION

2 points for winning the game and 1 point if the game is peeled
