

MEN & WOMEN'S OPEN PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIP

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

All games shall be played in accordance with:

- The laws of the sport of Bowls Crystal Mark 4TH Edition; and • Domestic regulations of Bowls South Africa; and the following Conditions of play

- All team members shall be from the same club.
- **Players shall be uniformly dressed in approved Club colours**
- Play starts at 8.30am for sectional play and at 9am for playoffs.
- The championship is to be played with three bowls on a league system in sections of four teams, over 18 ends. The play-offs of section winners shall be on a knockout basis [3 GAMES PER DAY- 3 BOWLS – 18 ENDS]
- **One trial** end is allowed at the start of each **sectional game**.
- **Two trial** ends are allowed at the start of each **playoff game**.
- Allocation of rinks. Round 1, open draw for rinks. Round 2, rinks will be assigned. Round 3, rinks will be assigned to if the play is in the same direction as rounds 1 & 2. If direction of play has changed then a open draw for rinks will take place.

POINTS ALLOCATION

2 points for winning the game and 1 point if the game is peeled

ALL OTHER CONDITIONS WILL BE SET OUT IN THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR ALL DISTRICT GAMES WHICH MUST BE DISPLAYED ON CLUB NOTICE BOARDS
